We are looking for passionate Regional Managers who will promote the concept of monetising time and talents for amazing, life-changing and life-saving causes.

100Percent empowers people to use their time and talents to help people in our local community while generating revenue to make a significant impact globally. The way we're doing this is through tutoring. Volunteers of 100Percent tutor student(s) and 100% of their tutoring revenue goes to a charitable cause. We've partnered with World Vision NZ and are currently building a new web application which will facilitate our growth. Tutors are currently able to raise funds for medical, educational, food security and social justice programmes run by World Vision NZ. In the not too distant future, 100Percent aims to move beyond tutoring to other skill sets and also allow volunteers to fundraise for a variety of amazing charities. This volunteer role is for the remainder of the 2014 academic year, requiring on average 5–8 hours a week though 10–15 hours may be required at the start of the semester to help facilitate our launch in your region. The successful applicant will be in charge of promoting 100Percent on their campus and recruiting and managing a team to help with promotion in specific faculties.

Responsibilities include:

1. Generating brand awareness in your university.
2. Recruiting tutors and advertising our services before and after the launch of 100Percent in your university. This may be done through posters, announcements in lectures, public presentations, social media, our own website and other creative ways you can think of!
3. Creating specific promotional campaigns to steer tutors to sign up to high-demand, high-revenue-generating subjects. Examples of such initiatives include [UMAT classes](#), Otago [PHSI 191](#) and [CHEM 191](#) basics group classes.
4. With the help and support of 100Percent HQ, recruiting and supporting a team who will help you promote 100Percent in specific faculties.
5. Creating a '100Percent community' around your campus by organising relevant events (Talks, Skyping the field, lunches...)

The ideal candidate should:

1. Have an interest in issues of poverty and justice and a fierce determination to make a difference.
2. Align with 100Percent's core values and have a good understanding of our competitive advantage.
3. Possess awesome leadership and people skills – you've got to love working, organising, motivating, challenging and inspiring those around you!
4. Have excellent communication skills – both written and verbal. You must be a confident public speaker.
5. Have the ability to effectively communicate on online social platforms and our web application.
6. Have a high level of professionalism and integrity.
7. Be able to take initiative and have a good DIY spirit!
