- 1. This Request for Expressions of Interest follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that appeared in dgMarket online 26th July 2011 and published Issue No 804, 16th August 2011 and re-advertised 31st October 2013.**
- 2. The Republic of Kiribati has received a grant from the International Development Association under the Pacific Aviation Investment Programme (PAIP) and it is intended to apply part of the proceeds to payments for Contracts – Consulting Services- Selection of an Individual Consultant- Aviation Advisor for the Civil Aviation Division of Kiribati (CAD).**
- 3. The Republic of Kiribati is currently implementing the Kiribati Aviation Investment Project (KAIP) as part of the regional Pacific Aviation Investment Program (PAIP) supported by The World Bank. The projects implementing Entity will be Tonga Airports Ltd, who will lead the projects via the TFSU "Technical and Fiduciary Services Unit" with each country's Project being led by an in-country**

Project Support Team (PST). The Project Support Team for the Kiribati Aviation Investment Project (KAIP), consisting of a Project Manager, Deputy Project Manager, Administrative Assistant and the Advisor will be established within the Ministry of Communications Transport and Tourism Development (MCTTD) with the specific responsibility for KAIP implementation.

4. The Ministry of Communications Transport and Tourism Development now invites interested and eligible consultant to provide their Expression of Interest for the post of the Kiribati Aviation Advisor. The purpose of the consultancy services is to:

- **Support the Civil Aviation Division of Kiribati in transforming into a separate regulatory body whilst remaining within the MCTTD structure.**
- **Support to MCTTD CAD to provide more effective and efficient safety and security oversight, including its relationships with PASO and with Operators;**
- **Support MCTTD in the development of its air transport sector in accordance with national aviation sector strategic goals.**

5. The detailed descriptions of the Scope of Services of the position are included in the Terms of Reference. It is anticipated that the Kiribati Aviation Advisor will commence as soon as possible for an initial two and a half year period.
