Dedicated lane on arrival for US Global Entry programme members

On 17 December 2012 New Zealand will open a dedicated lane for all US Global Entry members arriving at Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch airports.

This initiative is the result of an agreement between New Zealand and the United States to progressively improve the border experience for travellers flying between the two countries.

Customs and Immigration NZ have collaborated to ensure the introduction of the lane will make it easier for US Global Entry members travelling to New Zealand while maintaining the integrity of New Zealand's immigration system.

The lanes will streamline the arrival process for US Global Entry members. Lanes will be clearly signposted - US Global Entry. To be eligible to use the lanes Global Entry members simply present their Global Entry card, their US passport, and arrival documentation.

Global Entry members are subject to standard customs, immigration and biosecurity formalities.
