Aviation Industry Annual Conference Dunedin Town Hall June 17-21

Aviation is one of New Zealand's high growth sectors with an annual contribution to the New Zealand economy of around \$12Bn and growing at around 6% per annum.

With a highly skilled and well paid work force of over 23,000 employees the sector provides vital support to New Zealand two largest sectors – agriculture and tourism as well as providing the key connectedness of our people within New Zealand and to and from our country.

The sector is dominated by air travel however there are many other supporting sub sectors such as engineering including aircraft manufacture, training (flight, engineering and air traffic control), airport and infrastructure; design, repair and overhaul.

It's all coming to Dunedin where we put on show our DNA with 40 trades booths and over 100 speakers discussing a wide range of issues from safety in high reliability industries to the latest intelligence from the growth tiger markets of Asia, India, China and beyond.

This is the only aviation conference and exhibition in New Zealand facilitated by commercial aviation. This year the sector is also running a careers expo on 21 June.
