

The CAA has completed review of the submissions on the *Appropriate radio frequency for use outside controlled airspace* discussion document. The submissions have identified a range of support for both proposals with the majority showing a preference for the CFZ proposal. Major representative groups support both proposals with more supporting the CFZ proposal.

With this information the CAA wants to hold a meeting with aviation industry representative groups to further discuss this issue to inform a final position and agree on actions required.

This is an opportunity to get the major stakeholders around the table to discuss this issue and agree on a solution for the future. I will also discuss the CAA 2014-2016 airspace review process at this meeting.

As trying to get all parties together is a problem I will suggest a date and time for a meeting and following responses will finalise a date that appears to get as many participants as possible.
