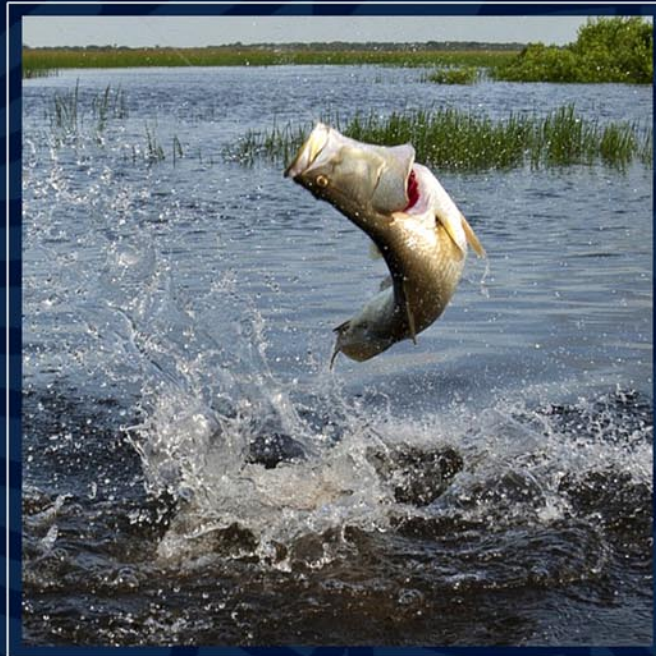

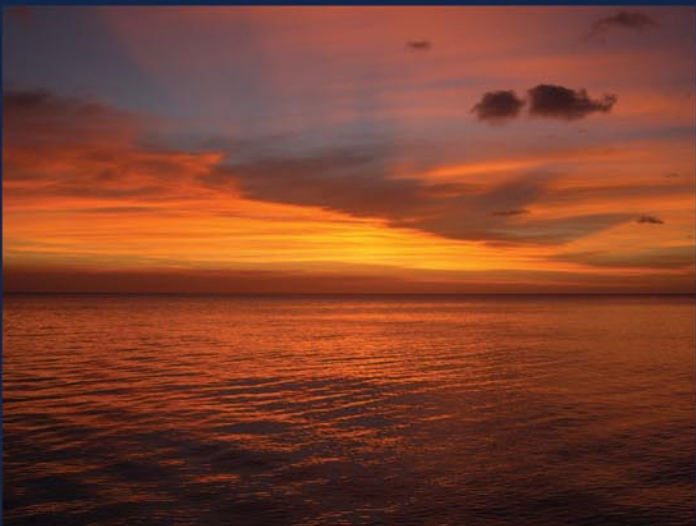

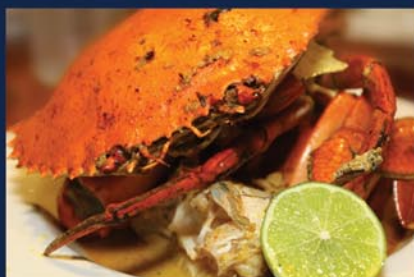


The Ultimate Sports Fish of the North

Barramundi have a reputation for being elusive, but your guide is up for the challenge and your "fishing machine" centre console is designed to meet any obstacle that the remote river areas present. The fishing is mixed, mainly casting among the snags and mangrove structures in the far northern estuaries, but also some trolling and live baiting, or try fly fishing for a change of pace.

Barramundi fishing is generally catch and release, but there's always the option to take a nice plate size barra back for the chef to cook up. Other catch and keep species include • Mud crabs • Coral trout • Giant trevally • Spanish mackerel • Mangrove jacks • Fingermark • Black jewfish • Threadfin salmon.



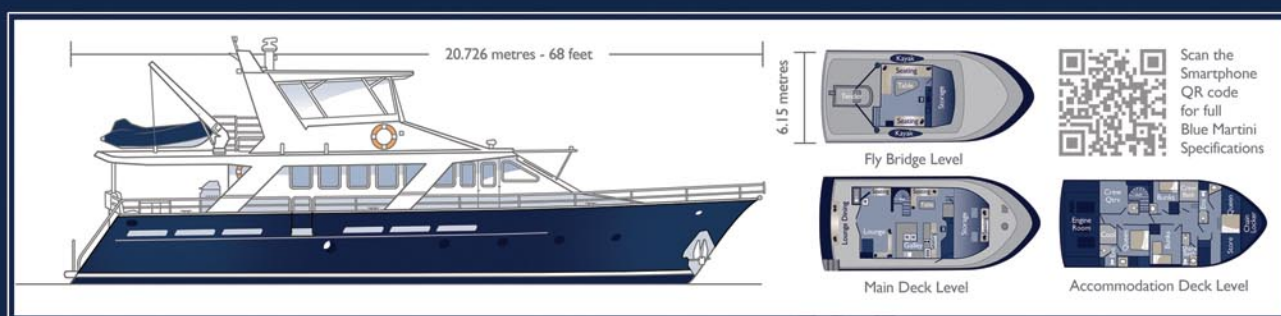
